BAG MEASURES

Width: 31 cm Height: 31 cm Depth: 8 cm



MATERIAL













INSTRUCTIONS

Cotton Yarn number 5 Crochet Hook 2.00 mm

NOTE: Using a bigger size of crochet hook, and yarn you get a larger bag.

Chain - CH

Slip Stitch - ST

Single Crochet - SC

Double Crochet - DC

End

GRANNY


Begin 4 CH closed with 1 ST.

1 Rnd: 3+2 CH. *3 DC into the ring of chains, 2 CH*. Repeat ** (3 times). 2 DC, 1 ST in the third CH. Change the color. 1 ST accross the chains.

2 Rnd: 3+2 CH, 3 DC in the chains below. *1 CH, 3 DC + 2 CH + 3 DC in the chains below*. Repeat ** (3 times). Close with 2 DC e 1 ST in the third ST.

3-4-5 Rnds: Repeat Round 2 working 3 DC + 2 CH + 3 DC only in the corners of granny.

6 Rnd: Work 1 SC in each stitch and 3 SC in the corners. Lock with 2 CH. Cut the yarn. Work 46 granny (see COLORS CHART).



BACK PANEL



Use black yarn to hook the corners of two granny square.



Join the granny squares working in SC in each stitch.




Hook the next two granny square in their corners.



Join the granny squares with 1 SC.



Work in SC until the end of the all granny squares (vertically).



At the end of the row, work 2 CH. Cut the thread. Repeat for each row.



Use black yarn to hook the corners of two granny square.



Join the granny squares working in SC in each stitch.



Work 1 SC in the vertical line.



Work in SC until the end of the all granny squares (horizontally).



At the end of the row, work 2 CH. Cut the thread. Repeat for each row.



Granny Squares joined.



Cut out two panels of eva rubber with the same dimensions of front and back panel of the bag.



Bag interior: apply hot glue on the horizontal line (see arrow), starting from the base.



Apply the hot glue on the vertical lines (see arrows).



Paste the sheet and repeat the procedure on the whole panel.



Glue both panels to the bag.
Cut out the eva rubber
with the same dimensions of the base.



Apply hot glue on the vertical lines (see previous photo).
Glue the panel to the base of the bag.



On the edge of back panel, using black yarn, work: *2 SC, skip 1 stitch, 4 DC in the same stitch, skip 1 stitch *. Repeat **.



At the end of the row, hook the corner of the side panel and join to the back panel.



Work in single crochet.



Work in SC up to the base.



Join the side panel at the base working in SC.



Lock with 2 chains, cut and hide the thread inside.



On the edge of frontal panel, using black yarn, work: *2 SC, skip 1 stitch, 4 DC in the same stitch, skip 1 stitch *. Repeat **.



At the end of the row, hook the corner of the side panel and join to the back panel.



Work in single crochet.




Inside of the bag.



Front of the bag.



Side of the bag.



Measure of front panel

+ side panel depth

+ 2 cm.





Cut out the fabric with measurements previously detected.



Fold the fabric in half and sew the sides, 1 cm from the edge.



Fold the corners of fabric at the base.





POCKET Work 2 granny squares number 45.



Join the granny squares in the center crocheting in single crochet.



Working in single crochet around the granny square.



On the long side of the pocket, work:

* 2 SC, skip 1 stitch, 4 DC in the same stitch, skip 1 stitch *. Repeat **.



Continue to work in single crochet around the granny square. Cut out the lining in the same size of pocket.



Sew or glue the fabric to the pocket.



Sew the pocket at the center and in the right side of the lining. Turn the fabric inside out.



Place the lining inside the bag and sew along the edge.



Cut and sew strips of fabric. Insert them inside the handles.



Place the handles in correspondence of black vertical lines.



Sew the handles inside the bag.



Bag completed.
